Marcie is great teacher and has the ability to meet drivers at their own level whether they are new to the sport or working to hone their competitive skills.

This will be a learning weekend with individual driving lessons and group sessions focused on learning about the sport of combined driving. Combined driving rules, driving safety, harness and carriage suitability and fitting, and presentation for competitions will all be addressed.

Friday & Saturday individual 1 hour lessons with Marcie Quist \$40 each
Sunday go through all three phases of a Horse Driving Trial with judging/coaching \$50 per entry
Four Corners Dressage and Combined Training Association non-member fee (for insurance) \$20 for each driver
There will be a dinner Saturday night at the farm for participants (included in entry) and their guests(\$10)

ASTM Approved helmets must be worn at all times while driving or riding.
Limited stabling available on site, some runs with covered areas, some 12 x 12 stalls.
Facilities include a full sized grass dressage arena, several hazards, and a cones course. All areas are fully fenced.
